After running the HDIS update, they would need to open HDIS Remote.

Once HDIS Remote is open they will need to click:

• Maintenance > Download Updates



- Once this screen appears, type "sync" and click Download from Web Site
- This will close out HDIS remote.
- Reopen HDIS remote







 Navigate to Maintenance > Utilities > Remote HDIS Setup > Environmental Initialization



- Select the modules that are used to Initialize them.
- Once finished, navigate to those modules.
- In the modules, under Maintenance, you will see a "Sync" option at the bottom



- Making sure there are no current exports, run "Init" This will copy (overwrite) the server contents into the Remote HDIS.
- Afterwards, run "Sync"



- Once all these steps are completed, Export/Import will now be done from each individual module by going into the Maintenance screen and clicking "Sync"
- Init only has to be done once during this initial setup phase.
